- 5. How effective is one dose of the COVID vaccine?
- 6. What could be expected from the second shot?
- 7. How long should I wait to get the vaccination it I have tested positive for COVID?
- 8. Which lasts longer, immunity after getting COVID-19 or protection from COVID vaccines?
- 9. Do the COVID vaccines protect against new variants? Is there any worry with the COVID variants that are popping up in UK, Brazil and South Africa?
